

Dreamweaver Quiz (3/5/09)

Defining Sites, Creating Files, Inserting Images and Text, & Creating Links

Define Your Site

Create a New Folder on your desktop and name it **Root-Folder**

- copy the **images** folder and **faq.htm** from the server into your **Root-Folder** (files are located at *Server > MICHAEL HAYES > Handouts > 030509-DW QUIZ*)
- in Dreamweaver define a New Site using **Root-Folder** as your Root Folder

Create Files

- create a New HTML File named **index.htm**, using the **2 column fixed, left sidebar, header & footer layout** in Dreamweaver and save it to your Root Folder
- create 3 more files (with the same layout) named **barns.htm**, **hardware.htm** & **tools.htm** and save each to **Root-Folder**

Homepage

Open **index.htm** in Dreamweaver

- change the Page Title to **Barn Information**
- insert the Image named **barnheader.jpg** into the header (delete *Header* text first)
- in the Main Content area of the file type a four line paragraph of text followed by a two line paragraph (after deleting all text already there)
- make sure you save periodically!!
- in the Footer area type the following line of text (after deleting *Footer* text)

- create a Line Break at the end of that text; on the next line type the following
[Home](#) | [Barns](#) | [Hardware](#) | [Tools](#) | [FAQ](#) | [MSP5 Class](#)
- select each word of text and link them to the appropriate HTML page (i.e. select *Barns* and link it to **barns.htm** file)
- select *MSP5 Class* and link it to the Butte College website
- select *Sales Support* on the line above and create an email link that will send an email to sales@barns.com
- select the **barnheader.jpg** image and create Image Maps over *Barns*, *Hardware* & *Tools*, linking each to the appropriate HTML page (i.e. the *Barns* Image Map should link to **barns.htm**)

Second Level Page

Open **barns.htm** in Dreamweaver

- change the Page Title to **Barns - Barns.com**
- insert the three barn images from your **images** folder (in the barns subfolder), creating ALT tags for each as you insert them

FAQ Page

Open **faq.htm** in Dreamweaver (a sample FAQ page for our company)

- create a Named Anchor next to each category running down the page (*Copyright in General, What Does Copyright Protect, etc.*)
- select each line of text in the right column and link it to the appropriate Named Anchors (*General Copyright, Copyright Protection, Who Can Register, Registering A Work, & Preregistration*)
